



# 6 STAGES OF MEDIATION

- 1. Before mediation begins, the mediator helps the parties decide where they should meet and who should be present.
- 2. Mediator's introduction. With the parties gathered together in the same room, the mediator introduces the participants, outlines the mediation process, and lays out ground rules.
- 3. Opening remarks. Each side then has the opportunity to present its view of the dispute without interruption. In addition to describing the issues they believe are at stake, they may also take time to vent their feelings.






#### **JAMES W. DALTON HIGHWAY**

Stan Lee didn't release his first big comic book until he was 40.




Vera Wang failed to make the Olympic figure skating team, didn't get the Editor-in-Chief position at Vogue, and designed her first dress at age 40.
